

LEGISLATIVE ADVOCATE OF THE YEAR AWARD

Steve Sweeney *Senate President*

Steve Sweeney entered public service after his daughter was born with Down syndrome. Horrified at the manner in which individuals with disabilities were treated, he vowed to make a difference in not just his daughter's life, but in the lives of those in his community. He has been a leading advocate impacting numerous laws to protect individuals with disabilities. Two bills which he sponsored in 2018 have been approved, and are now strengthening protections for students with disabilities and relieving the burden of costs of motor vehicle registrations for drivers of persons with disabilities.

Previously Senator Sweeney worked to establish a registry of offenders of individuals with developmental disabilities to prevent continued abuse, wrote the law that changed references of "mental retardation" to "intellectual disability" or "developmental disability," authored legislation that prohibits discrimination against organ transplant recipients on the basis of mental or physical disability, a law requiring that school districts ensure that students with disabilities have opportunities to participate in athletic activities, and a measure requiring that school buses transporting individuals with disabilities use flashing lights. Sweeney has also fought for state funding for programs and housing for this population.

Senate President Steve Sweeney represents the Third Legislative District, which includes portions of Gloucester and Cumberland counties and all of Salem County. He served on the Gloucester County Board of Chosen Freeholders from 1997 to 2010 and was Freeholder Director from 1998 until 2010. First elected to the New Jersey



Senate in 2001, he has been reelected five times. He was chosen by the Democratic Majority to lead the Senate in 2009 and was selected by his Senate Democratic colleagues to maintain his leadership position again in 2013 and 2017. Senator Sweeney was born on June 11, 1959 in Camden and is a graduate of Pennsauken High School. Senator Sweeney and his wife, Patti, were married in 1986. They live in West Deptford and have two children, Stephen and Lauren.

TRAILBLAZER AWARD

C. Vivian Stringer *Head Coach, Women's Basketball, Rutgers University*

One of the most recognizable names and faces in all of college basketball, **C. Vivian Stringer** has built an illustrious career highlighted by countless unforgettable moments and is on the cusp of becoming only one of a handful of collegiate coaches to reach the 1,000 career victory milestone. She is the parent of a daughter with multiple significant disabilities who will accompany her to the *PLAN/NJ 30th Anniversary: A Celebration of Abilities* event.



In her 47 seasons, Stringer has transformed three programs into national title contenders. She is a 2001 inductee into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, was named one of the "101 Most Influential Minorities in Sports" by Sports Illustrated in 2003, and served as an assistant coach for the gold-medal winning U.S. Olympic Team in 2004.

Stringer prides herself on not only teaching her players the game of basketball, but more importantly providing them life lessons that stand the test of time. Her perseverance and strength in the eyes of adversity have meant the most to the people around her. A coal miner's daughter, Stringer learned a valuable lesson from her parents growing up in the small tight-knit community of Edenborn in western Pennsylvania: "Work hard and don't look for excuses, and you can achieve anything."

FRED R. PATTERSON PARENT ADVOCATE AWARD

Mercedes Witowsky *Executive Director,
The New Jersey Council on Developmental Disabilities (NJCDD)*

Mercedes Witowsky has been privileged to work in the field supporting individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) and other disabilities for nearly 40 years. In addition, she has championed multiple family advocacy efforts across the state. Equality, citizenship, choice and control are at the core of her personal values and beliefs.

Witowsky has been a driving force in establishing a Family Advisory Council to the NJ Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD), providing valuable input as the system transitions to Fee for Service. She led the creation of the NJ Developmental Disabilities Advocacy Network (DDAN), bringing together stakeholders to establish and implement a collective advocacy agenda. On the national level, she served for 15 years as the state's representative to the American Network of Community Options and Resources (ANCOR). Her advocacy efforts have focused on strengthening the voices of self-advocates and families to communicate their needs to service providers and government agencies.

Witowsky earned her teaching degree in Special Education from Kean University. She is also the proud parent of Anthony and of Tina, a young lady with multiple disabilities.

Her commitment is to be part of the solution that guides New Jersey to be a reliable and sustainable system for the thousands of services recipients in our great state.



LIFE PLANNING PARTNER AWARDS

Daniel and Carmelita Blackford

Daniel Blackford has engaged in health and strength-building activities for more than 17 years. He is a longtime member of an adaptive ski and sports program in Vermont; trained for the Special Olympics held at Bridgewater High School; and participates in hippotherapy using a horse to improve weight bearing. Daniel's weekly music therapy sessions allow him to participate as a choir member by using a hand switch to elicit sound through a music synthesizer.



He and his mother **Carmelita** have travelled to Tokyo, Hong Kong and Argentina. "One of Daniel's favorite Broadway shows is *Evita*, so we went to Buenos Aires to track down Eva Perón's roots," said Carmelita.

"A person living with a tracheostomy and feeding button is not necessarily restricted in what they can do," she explained. "Every day is a gift! Every day we look for something to do better."

Joseph Kearns

Joseph has discovered a love for travel and, after two trips to Disneyland, shows no signs of slowing down. We regularly receive wonderful, detailed written pieces from him detailing his interests. Several years ago he passed through difficult times, and PLAN/NJ was able to arrange for him to live in a new supported living home.



He also participates in several meaningful daytime activities and feels safe, comfortable, productive and fulfilled. Joseph is supported by PLAN/NJ and by other caregivers to pursue his interests and passions. Despite living with developmental disabilities, he leads an independent life, in part because of the Guardianship services he receives from PLAN/NJ. He volunteers for a number of non-profit agencies doing a variety of tasks to benefit the broader community including collating marketing materials. Joseph enjoys a meaningful relationship with the PLAN/NJ Director of Social Services and with the other residents and the staff where he lives.

Brandon Smith

Brandon discovered his love and talent for playing piano at only five years old. While visiting a museum with his family, he played a piano game that required him to repeat the notes he heard by hitting the correct keys. “Brandon won the game with 100% accuracy,” explained his mother, Amy. “We found out that this was called “perfect pitch.” We immediately arranged for a piano and never looked back. Brandon sat down and played Mozart the same day that we brought it home. He knew the music by heart because for years he had listened to Baby Mozart DVDs.”

Brandon enjoyed playing piano on his own and was self-taught until 4th grade, when the family decided it was time for piano lessons so that he could learn to read music. He has



continued with the same music teacher until this day. He added additional lessons during his sophomore year of high school to help him prepare for recitals. Today, he receives two piano lessons per week and gives two recitals per year, in addition to performing at his high school concerts.

Above all other genres of music, Brandon's favorite style is classical. He loves Mozart, Beethoven, Chopin and many more. In addition, he loves to play any music that is meaningful to him. He practices well in advance of any concert or end of year show, and loves to simply sit down and play any music that he hears.

Brandon currently attends Howell High School with a 1:1 aide in the Autism Program. At 21, he will transition into an adult program, which the family hopes will have a music component.

OUTSTANDING STAFF MEMBER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Nadine Hoston

Service Coordinator, PLAN/NJ

Nadine became familiar with PLAN/NJ when she met and began working with Barbara Sandstrom, a former PLAN/NJ Board Member, at Thomas Edison State University, and became close with Barbara's sister Mary, a PLAN/NJ client. When discovering all the good that PLAN/NJ does, and the assistance and comfort staff gives to families and clients, she quickly became committed to the mission and followed Barbara's advice that she apply for a job.

As the daughter of a mentally disabled mother, Nadine has a personal connection and understanding of what families go through as they try to care for and assure their loved one's well-being. If I do, it is because I understand the challenges, and I want to be the helping hand for our clients and their families."

Born and raised in Charleston, West Virginia, Nadine graduated in 1986 with a BS/BA in Communications and Sociology from Marshall University in Huntington.
